

## INCIDENT SUSPENSION POLICY

1. EJECTION FROM A GAME (in any one season)

(Examples include ejection from disputes over calls, etc. with no physical violence or verbal threats).

1<sup>st</sup> Offense -

1 game

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense -

3 games

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense -

5 games continuing into the following sports program

2. VERBALLY THREATENING AN OFFICIAL, PLAYER OR SPECTATOR.

1<sup>st</sup> Offense -

3 games

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense -

5 games

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense -

Indefinite (hearing with a minimum 1 ½ seasons).

3. FIGHTING WITH ANOTHER PLAYER

1<sup>st</sup> Offense -

3 games

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense -

5 games

3rd Offense -

Indefinite (hearing with a minimum 1 season).

4. PHYSICALLY TOUCHING AN OFFICIAL OR SPECTATOR

1st Offense -

1 ½ seasons (hearing if requested)

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense -

suspension with a 3-year minimum (hearing if requested).

5. TEAM WARNINGS (team probation)

1st Offense -

team warning that any additional problems will result in elimination from

the program and forfeiture of any entry fees, etc.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense -

elimination as a team from the program.

## 6. CONTINUED ABUSERS

Players appearing on the suspension list for a minimum of five times in five years may be permanently eliminated from the program.

## **SUSPENSION RULES:**

- a. Suspensions include playing, coaching or speculating in the vicinity of a playing field or gymnasium.
- b. Suspensions may carry over from season to season, and sport to sport.
- c. Hearings may include statements by the officials, players involved, Department of Recreation staff as well as spectators.
- d. All decisions on suspensions will be rendered by the Tonawanda Recreation Department.
